## *Historic Site Etiquette*

### **Do not touch the objects or displays**

*Oils from your hands can damage the art and historic items.*

### **Keep 12 inches from the art**

*Art can easily be bumped by accident. Help us care for the collection by keeping a safe distance.*

### **No food or drinks in the galleries & historic rooms**

*Outdoor picnicking encouraged; Carry In-Carry Out!*

**No pets allowed** *Except while leashed & attended in the picnic area only. Waste must be picked up & carried out. If leaving animal in the car make sure there is proper ventilation or the police will be contacted by caring visitors and staff.*

**Service animals welcome** *throughout the property, please the notify the Admissions Desk. Note: therapy animals are not protected under ADA or MA state regulations and thus only allowed in picnic area as described above.*

### **No backpacks**

*If unable to leave in your vehicle, please wear it on your front to avoid bumping the artwork.*

**Child carriers** *Children may be worn in front carriers. In an effort to protect the art collection, backback carriers are not permitted in historic rooms or galleries.*

**Compact strollers permitted**  
*Umbrella strollers permitted in galleries & historic rooms, please leave larger strollers outside. We have one stroller available for use (first come, first served).*

visit our activity space in the Art Lab!*

**Personal photography allowed**  
*using small handheld devices without flash. No selfie sticks or free-standing equipment permitted.*

*inquire at the Admissions Desk*
